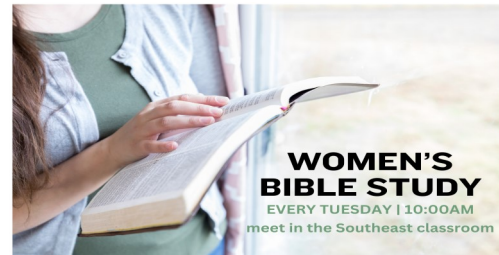

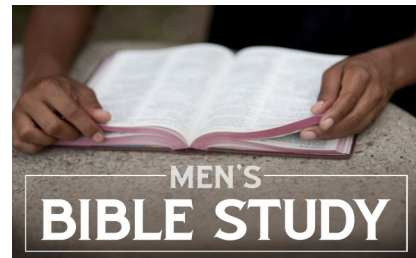


Tuesday Bible Study

Monetary donations are also accepted. Please be sure to note "food pantry" on the memo line of your check. November 5 and December 10 will be our next open food pantry distributions. For anyone who wants to help, set up is at 2:15pm. Clients are served 3:30-5pm. Please encourage those who may be food insecure to visit us!

Helene. Milton. The devastation from the Southeast is overwhelming and heartbreaking. **With damage on this scale, how can we make a difference?** What relief agencies can we trust?

Our United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) is providing an opportunity to offer real, meaningful help with the confidence that 100% of our donations will go directly to disaster response and recovery here, in our country.

We have already begun to make donations to UMCOR, THANK YOU for your generosity. If you have not yet given, you may place your check made out to Savoy UMC, memo: hurricane relief.

Another concrete way to help is to provide UMCOR with cleaning kits to help people in need. These time-tested kits include a five-gallon bucket filled with the cleaning supplies that are especially useful for making a home safe to live in again – and that are often especially hard to find in areas where they are most needed.

One of these buckets is a real, tangible expression of how much others care. The list, which you can find on the Welcome Center at church, is **very specific** in terms of sizes and types of supplies, so that all of the items will fit in a five-gallon bucket.

Home Depot will graciously provide the buckets and lids. You can shop locally for all of the items for one cleaning kit, shop for some of those items, use **our Amazon list** to easily pur-



chase items to be sent directly to the church or donate money so that others can do the shopping for you. Checks should have "food buckets" in the memo line. Drop off your items to the church **before Wednesday, Nov. 13.**

Anyone interested in helping assemble the kits can join in a **kit-making party at Quest UMC in Urbana on Saturday, November 16, at 1:00pm.** Quest will then deliver the kits to Midwest Mission. Contact Cindy Cook at 217-841-0420 with questions.

Let's set our goal to fill at least 25 buckets!
